



Balcony Gardening

AMARYLLIS



Trumpet-shaped blooms add a flamboyant and bold statement to gardens and homes



Bulbs grow for many years and if planted, will keep on blooming, provided they receive enough sun and water



Need good quality potting soil, with adequate drainage holes to thrive



Position in bright indirect light and water only if the soil has dried out (keeping them dry ensures they do not rot)



Feed every 6 weeks after flowering, then let soil dry out in April so bulb can go dormant



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
